

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE PROVISIONS OF
THE CARPENTERSVILLE MUNICIPAL CODE, TITLE 20, "FEES AND FINES,"
CHAPTER 20.02, "FEES"**

WHEREAS, the Village of Carpentersville, Kane County, Illinois, is a home rule municipality in accordance with the Constitution of the State of Illinois of 1970; and

WHEREAS, the Village of Carpentersville is authorized to adopt ordinances and promulgate rules and regulations that pertain to its government and affairs and that protect the health, safety, and welfare of its citizens; and

WHEREAS, the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Carpentersville have previously approved a Fuel and Environmental Fee to offset fuel and environmental regulation costs associated with residential scavenger service; and

WHEREAS, it is deemed reasonable, necessary, and in the best interest of the Village of Carpentersville to increase the amount of the Fuel and Environmental Fee.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Carpentersville, Kane County, Illinois, as follows:

SECTION 1: The Carpentersville Municipal Code, Title 20, "Fees and Fines," Chapter 20.02, "Fees," is hereby amended by revising the schedule of fees within Section 20.02.020, "Other fees established," as follows:

Garbage Collection

283 Supplemental fuel and environmental fee per residential building or unit
\$6.00 per month
Section 8.08.015

SECTION 2: Those sections, paragraphs, and provisions of the Village of Carpentersville Municipal Code which are not expressly amended or repealed by this Ordinance are hereby reenacted, and it is expressly declared to be the intention of this Ordinance not to amend or repeal any portions of the Village of Carpentersville Municipal Code other than those expressly amended or repealed in Section 1 of this Ordinance.

SECTION 3: The invalidity of any section or provision of this Ordinance hereby passed and approved shall not invalidate other sections or provisions thereof.

SECTION 4: The provisions of this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon its passage, approval, and publication in accordance with law.
