

ORDINANCE NO. 09-27

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE PROVISIONS OF THE
CARPENTERSVILLE MUNICIPAL CODE, SECTION 15.50.020, SUBSECTION
A4 RELATING TO THE PARKING OF VEHICLES IN RESIDENTIAL AREAS**

WHEREAS, the President and Board of Trustees have heretofore adopted by reference, the provisions of the International Property Maintenance Code, 2006; and

WHEREAS, Section 15.50.020 of the Carpentersville Municipal Code adopted certain amendments to said International Property Maintenance Code; and

WHEREAS, Section 15.50.020 A 4 amends the International Property Maintenance Code by adding provisions regarding exterior property areas and adds a Subsection 302.23 setting forth requirements for parking and vehicle storage; and

WHEREAS, the President and Board of Trustees deem it to be in the best interests of the Village to amend Subsection 302.43(10) pertaining to the parking of vehicles in residential areas and to relocate such provision to Chapter 10.24 of the Municipal Code and to increase the vehicle license fee as to certain classifications of vehicles.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Carpentersville, Kane County, Illinois, as follows:

SECTION 1:

The Carpentersville Municipal Code, Section 15.50.020 A 4, Section 302.43 (10) is hereby repealed.

SECTION 2:

The Carpentersville Municipal Code, Title 10, "Vehicles and Traffic", Chapter 10.24, "Stopping Standing and Parking" is hereby amended by adding Section 10.24.125, entitled " Residential Parking Restrictions", which shall read as follows:

10.24.125 Residential Parking Restrictions

- A. The parking or storage of any vehicle having a gross weight capacity (including vehicle and maximum load) in excess of 10,000 pounds, shall be prohibited on any street, alley, right-of-way or easement in residentially

zoned areas of the Village and on any private property in residentially zoned areas of the Village, except as otherwise posted to the contrary.

- B. The provisions of this subsection shall not apply to any vehicle making a delivery or picking up a load or performing a requested service at a particular residence, in which case the vehicle may be driven on such street, alley, right-of-way or easement only for the minimum distance necessary to make the delivery or pickup or to perform the requested service and shall remain parked on the premises or adjacent to the premises where the delivery, pickup or requested service is being performed only the minimum time required to make the delivery or pickup or to perform the requested service.

SECTION 3:

The Carpentersville Municipal Code, Title 20, "Fees and Fines", Chapter 20.02, "Fees", Section 20.02.010. Subsection 89, is amended to read:

89	Class D	8,001 to 10,000 lbs. Gross vehicle weight	\$125.00
89A	Class D	10,001 to 12,000 lbs. Gross vehicle weight	\$ 40.00

SECTION 4:

Those sections, paragraphs, and provisions of the Village of Carpentersville Municipal Code which are not expressly amended or repealed by this Ordinance are hereby re-enacted, and it is expressly declared to be the intention of this Ordinance not to repeal or amend any portions of the Village of Carpentersville Municipal Code other than those expressly amended or repealed in Sections 1, 2, and 3 of this Ordinance.

SECTION 5:

The invalidity of any section or provision of this Ordinance hereby passed and approved shall not invalidate other sections or provisions thereof.

SECTION 6:

The provisions of this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon its passage, approval and publication, in accordance with law.

Motion made by Trustee Teeter, seconded by Trustee McFeggan, that the Ordinance be passed.
