

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CARPENTERSVILLE MUNICIPAL CODE  
REGARDING WATER AND SEWER RATES**

**WHEREAS**, the Village of Carpentersville operates a municipal water system and a municipal sewer system; and

**WHEREAS**, the President and Board of Trustees have heretofore adopted ordinances establishing water and sewer rates to pay for the costs of the operation and maintenance of the municipal water system and the municipal sewer system; and

**WHEREAS**, the Village Manager has caused an examination of the current water and sewer rates and has recommended that the water and sewer rates charged by the Village of Carpentersville be increased in order to adequately cover the costs incurred by the Village in the operation and maintenance of the municipal water system and the municipal sewer system; and

**WHEREAS**, the President and Board of Trustees find that it is reasonable and appropriate to increase the water rates and the sewer rates in order to adequately cover the costs incurred by the Village in the operation and maintenance of the municipal water system and the municipal sewer system.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED** by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Carpentersville, Kane County, Illinois, as follows:

**SECTION 1:** The Carpentersville Municipal Code, Title 13, "Public Services," Chapter 13.08, "Water and Sewer Rates," Section 13.08.020, "Water and Sewer Rates," Subsection A, is hereby amended and as amended shall read as follows:

**13.08.020 Water and Sewer Rates**

- A. Rates to be charged for water supplied from the municipal water system and for the municipal sewer service shall be based on the water meter reading each quarter as follows:
  - 1. Water Rates: For all water consumed or used commencing June 1, 2010, and thereafter, the consumer shall pay three dollars and ten cents (\$3.10) per one thousand gallons.
  - 2. Sewer Rates: For all water consumed or used commencing June 1, 2010, and thereafter, the consumer shall pay three dollars and forty-five cents (\$3.45) per one thousand gallons for use of the sanitary sewer system.

Each and every water user or consumer shall pay a basic minimum quarterly rate for water billed during June 2010, and thereafter, in the amount of fifteen dollars (\$15.00) for residential users and thirty dollars (\$30.00) for commercial users.

**SECTION 2:** Those sections, paragraphs, and provisions of Chapter 13.08 of the Village of Carpentersville Municipal Code which are not expressly amended or repealed by this Ordinance are hereby reenacted, and it is expressly declared to be the intention of this Ordinance not to repeal or amend any portions of the Village of Carpentersville Municipal Code other than those expressly amended or repealed in Section 1 of this Ordinance.

**SECTION 3:** The invalidity of any section or provision of this Ordinance hereby adopted and approved shall not invalidate other sections or provisions thereof.

**SECTION 4:** The provisions of this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon its adoption, approval, and publication in accordance with law.
