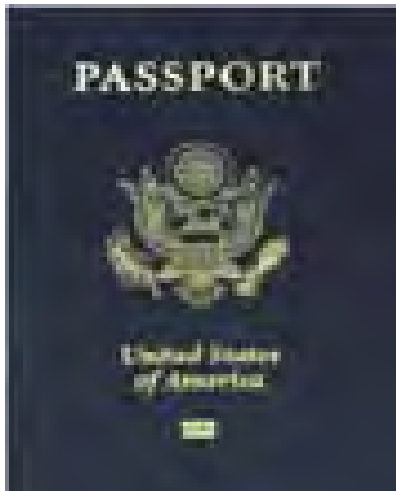

<u>Type</u>	<u>Regular Service</u> 4-6 weeks	<u>Expedited Service</u> 2-3 weeks – must bring in an express mail stamp for \$18.30 from USPS To ensure this service – (same family members applications can be put in one envelope, hence only one stamp is needed – 5-6 application maximum)
Adult	\$75.00 Passport \$20.00 Passport Card	\$149.96 (includes overnight mail service <u>return</u> )
Child	\$60.00 Passport \$10.00 Passport Card	\$134.96 (Includes overnight mail service <u>return</u> )

Check payable to: US Department of State – one check/money order required per application.

Processing fee: 25.00 per passport/card – Checks or cash payable to Kane County Clerk – if multiple applications, processing fee can be combined on one check.

Fee for Passport Photos (2) \$13.00
